

1. Parish Census efforts: The parish census process is complete. To date, we have received back a total of 90 census forms. A few people responded verbally. Currently, there are a total of 99 families indicating that they want to remain registered with Blessed Trinity. Of that number, there are approximately 10 families/individuals that are shut-in or in nursing homes. Another approximately 10 families/individuals who want to remain registered but are essentially inactive (In other words, do not participate in the parish with their time, talent or treasure.
